Donor Privacy Policy

For over 20 years, we’ve respected and protected donor privacy. We know privacy is important to you and it is vital to our organization. This document explains our Privacy Policy. We want you to know how we keep our donor information private and secure and use it to serve you better.

Who is covered by the Privacy Policy?

This Privacy Policy applies to all consumers and businesses who have given monetary donations, in-kind donations, and time; and to volunteers, staff members and any other person(s) who have actively supported our Organization.

You may have given monetary support or other support as outlined in the above paragraph as early as 1997 or later. Our Organization humbly appreciates each donor and supporter who gives of their time and money. The fact that you have given your support shows that you care. We have a responsibility to acknowledge your support by being fiscally conservative and good stewards of your donations that are given to us, and to protect your donor privacy regarding your support.

We provide this Donor Privacy Policy to supporters when they ask for it. We also provide it annually after that. If we make a major change to our Donor Privacy Policy we will notify you.

Protecting the Privacy of Our Customer Information

We are very serious about protecting the privacy of your information. We maintain safeguards that comply with Federal and State standards to store and secure information about your donation history. The safeguards may be physical, electronic or procedural. The safeguards protect information against unauthorized access, alteration and destruction. For example, we have control policies that permit access to your donor information only by people we believe need access to do their work.

Information We Have About You.

Our organization collects information about you from the support and donations that you make to us. This information may include your name, address, telephone number, fax number, and the amount of donations you have given to our organization. This information may include whether you gave by direct mail, telephone, or special event. This is the only information that we keep for our records. From time to time we may use this information to keep you current about our Organization by mailing, calling, or faxing relevant material for your consideration.

Information our Organization Shares.

WE DO NOT SHARE ANY INFORMATION ABOUT YOU WITH ANYONE. YOUR INFORMATION IS KEPT CONFIDENTIAL AND PRIVATE. WE DO NOT RENT LISTS OR NAMES TO OTHER ORGANIZATIONS. WE RESPECT YOUR PRIVACY AND WISH TO KEEP YOU AS A FUTURE SUPPORTER.
